During the Cold War, Arturo spent several months in jail for listening to Jazz music on an American radio station in Cuba.

Arturo loves all types of music, but jazz is his true passion.

Arturo is an advocate of freedom around the world and has said many times, "Without freedom there is no life."

Arturo is now a U.S. citizen and was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Barack Obama in 2013.

Arturo practices music 6-7 hours a day and writes new songs daily.

Arturo has won 10 Grammy awards and performed with many famous musicians including Tony Bennett, Gloria Estefan, Frank Sinatra, Dizzy Gillespie, and Tito Puente.
